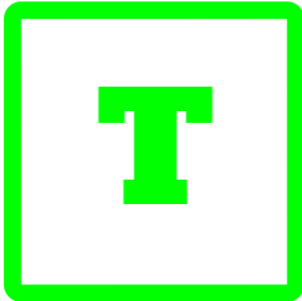

Draw a square with a "T" inside of it in the left-hand column and the info across in the right-hand column. Put your info in quotation marks and cite the page number on which you found it. Highlight in **GREEN**. (Minimum 2 per set of notes)



Light Bulb: Include connections you have made to information in your notes. These connections can be to material discussed in previous notes, to current events, or to your personal experience. Draw and highlight the light bulb in the left-hand column and your connections in the right-hand column. Highlight in **ORANGE**. (Minimum 2 per set of notes)

Highlight **EACH** key term in **YELLOW** in the left-hand column.
